Transport and Environment Committee Activity and Decisions

The committee met on 17 May 2018 and today (20 June 2018).

17 May 2018

- Note that a report concerning the Water of Leith – Improvement Proposals (Dean to Stockbridge Section) is being prepared for the Committee and is to be presented to it on 9 August 2018.
- Councillor Osler proposed a motion for the Council to consider remedies for the issues of flooding and access to Inverleith Park; a report is being prepared and was presented at today’s meeting. (See below.)
- It is proposed to introduce a resident permit surcharge to all diesel vehicles.
- It has been proposed that a *citywide* ban on all temporary on-street advertising structures be imposed. Implementation of the ban is expected to take place in late autumn 2018.

- The report instigated by Councillor Osler at the last meeting (see above) reported that some of the existing drainage system is no longer able to effectively drain surface water given the frequency and scale of current rainfall events. It is therefore proposed that the ineffective sections are replaced with larger and better aligned piping, and that the installation of lateral and secondary field drainage supplements these. A bid for capital funding will be made as part of the 2019/20 budget process.
