**Notices and general information**

1. The Water of Leith clean-up for the Stockbridge section has been scheduled for Sunday, 2<sup>nd</sup> June from 10.30 AM to 12.30 PM. Volunteers should meet at Falshaw Bridge. The leader from the Water of Leith Conservation Trust will be Helen Brown and will provide all the equipment and organise the pick up from the Council's task force.
2. The Council has proposed a range of changes to the operation of parking controls, all of which are linked to the Parking Action Plan (PAP) details of which can be found at [www.edinburgh.gov.uk/parkingactionplan](http://www.edinburgh.gov.uk/parkingactionplan). The Council has appointed Project Centre to undertake an informal consultation on key elements of the proposals which will give Community Councils an opportunity to view and comment upon the proposals before they are advertised. The two elements included within this consultation are:
  - **Shared-use parking:** Increased provision of shared-use parking across the Central and Peripheral Zones (1-8) of the Controlled Parking Zone. Approximately 2,000 extra spaces will be made available to permit holders.
  - **Double yellow lines:** To protect junctions and pedestrian crossing points, existing single yellow lines are being upgraded to double yellow lines to enhance road safety.
