**Notices and general information**

1. The Water of Leith clean-up for the Stockbridge section on Sunday, 2<sup>nd</sup> June was well-attended and the improvement was noticeable.

**Transport, Infrastructure and Environment Committee Activity and Decisions**

The committee last met on 16 May 2019. On 5 March it approved the selected locations for 66 on-street charging points across 16 hubs in the city and recommended that charging should be in pence per minute rather than per kWh; implementation to take place during most of 2020.
